Chemical usage process

- ◆ Must be stirred before use
- ◆ Can be diluted with solvent before use.

Manner of packing

25 kg per plastic drum

Storage and shelf life

- ◆ Transportation and storage of non-hazardous chemicals
- ◆ Cool, dry and sealed storage
- ◆ Shelf life: 24 months from the date of production

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
